

Admissions Requirements of Shandong First Medical University

I. International students must observe laws and rules in China and rules and regulations in the university, and respect the public morality and social customs in China.

II. Holding religious activities in Chinese boundary International students should observe administrative of religious activities for foreigners in the People Republic of China. International students' national customs and religious belief are also respected in our university. But the place held for religious rites cannot be offered. Religious missionary work is forbidden.

III. International students shall not be engaged in such illegal activities as gambling, excessive drinking, engaging in a brawl, taking drugs, drug smuggling, eroticism, prostitution, stealing or other misbehavior to interfere teaching, scientific researches or living order in the university. No one can be allowed to destroy the teaching, scientific researches and living order in the university, and to disturb other's activities based on the rules in the university. Students who came back to campus after vacations will also be found guilty if they have been tested using drugs(including marijuana).

IV. Students should clear the new academic year fees within 30 days after the opening of school. Students who fail to pay fees on time shall not registered as new semester students, their school will be suspended. Students will not be allowed in classes and examinations and their visa will not be extended.

V. Points for attention in safety details:

1. Obey the public traffic rules. Driving without licenses is illegal. Be careful with road safety. Purchase of motor vehicles is not allowed. It is forbidden to drive motor vehicles on campus.

2. Observe the university's study and rest schedule. If you cannot attend the classes, make sure ask for a leave before classes.

3. Keep quiet in the dormitory building. Smoking is prohibited. Do not drink excessively. Do not make loud noise. Do not put up external students for the night. Every night go back own apartment before 23:00. International students are not allowed to live outside the campus, lodging in the school must obey the administrative rules. Boys are not allowed to stay in girl's dormitories or vice versa.

4. Students' dormitories will be arranged by the Students Management and Service Center accordingly. Students cannot change the room without permission from the office.

5. If you want to hold activities or performance, you should submit your written application to the School of International Education two weeks in advance. If being approved, activities can be held at the appointed time and place.

6. International students should take good care of the facilities in the dormitory and the classroom. Do not remove the public facilities without permission. Do not change the water or electricity equipment. If any furniture or equipment is lost or damaged, students should pay the loss or damage according to the cost. International students should keep the dorm clean and tidy. Raising pets is forbidden.

7. Economize on water and electricity use. Electricity supply should be cut off when you are out. Attention should be paid to fire prevention and without permission electric lines are not allowed to use. Students who cause fire must pay for all the damages and be responsible for all the consequences.

8. Take good care of your properties. Make sure to lock the doors and shut the windows when you are out, otherwise you will be responsible for all the lost. If your property is lost, you should report the whole case to School of International Education and Public Security Bureau right away, so that immediate measures can be taken to look for your loss.

9. Distributing, posting and displaying posters without permission are forbidden. Spreading reactionary or pornographic things are forbidden. When using the Internet, students should abide by the Chinese laws and provisions, do not browse, copy and spread the content that is forbidden by Chinese laws.

10. If you want to travel or go back home during festivals or holidays, you should register your destination and fill in the departure form. Off-campus students must follow the related entry and exit regulations for foreigners.

11. If you pay no attention to our university's disciplines, and if you have behaviors like destroying public property, get involved in excessive drinking, fighting and damaging other's property, you will be fined according to the seriousness of the case. If the case is very serious, you will be punished according to relative Public Order Regulations of China. Students misbehaved again after education, might be expelled from the university and be sent back to your country.

12. In case of emergency, please call: 110, 120, 122 and 119.

VI. If International students fail to abide by the rules and regulations above, they are responsible for all the consequences.

VII. Points for admission

1. Applicant should pass the test inspection organized by our university (video or on-site);

2. The applicant should pay the registration fee and admission deposit on time after receiving the per-admission notice;
3. Applicants should register in university at the appointed time;
4. The applicant should pass the physical examination organized by us;
5. The applicant must pass the entrance examination(Pharmacy: English, physics, chemistry, biology; Chinese language training: Chinese, English, physics, chemistry, biology);
6. Pay up tuition, insurance, accommodation and other expenses.

Applicants must comply with and complete the above conditions, or they will not be admitted .

VIII. Points for teaching details:

1. According to the Regulation Rules for International Students, students should pass all the exams before starting their internship. Students with more than specified failing subjects are not allowed to start their internship.

2. School of International Education has strict requirements for attendance. Students who don't meet the requirements will be forbidden in final exams.

3. For Chinese language trainees, it is required that after one year of Chinese learning, students should reach HSK 4; those who fail to reach HSK 4 can choose to leave the university or apply for continuing to study Chinese, and pay the tuition fee according to the normal Chinese language training standard until they pass. Chinese language trainees who have passed HSK4 and are in good health and willing to continue their study can choose the undergraduate program of clinical medicine in September current year. It is required to promise that, if you continue to learn clinical medicine, your Chinese must reach level 5 of *International Chinese Proficiency Standard* before your internship.

4. For pharmacy(taught in English) students, it is required to promise that your Chinese must reach level 4 of *International Chinese Proficiency Standard* before graduation.

All the regulations above are known clearly by me, and I am voluntary to observe them.
